

Tournament Proposition

DATE

May 17-19, 2024

PLACE

STAREZ ARÉNA VODOVA, Vodova 108, 612 00 Brno

CATEGORY

GU15 - primarily players born 2009 and 2010, also players born 2011 and 2012

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Registration deadline is April 15, 2024. The tournament can play only teams which will register and pay the tournament fee by April 20, 2024.

The inclusion of a team after April 20 2024 is fully within the competence of the tournament director (substitute team, supplementing the group with the same number of teams).

TOURNAMENT FEE

5 000 CZK/per team (210 EUR). The fee must be paid by April 20, 2024. The registration of a team whose entry fee is not paid by the given date will be excluded from the tournament applications. After the April 20, 2024, in case of cancellation by the registered team, the entry fee is non-refundable.

The fee includes: entrance fee for all matches, identification bracelet, public transport ticket for the duration of the tournament and other events of the accompanying program.

RULES

The tournament is played according to the IFF rules on the field 36x18 meters.

GAME TIME

Groups and in the playoffs, 3 x 10 min (net time). Breaks between periods 2 min. Time to prepare for the match 5 min. In case of a draw, follows 5 minutes overtime (only in playoffs).

TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

2 groups of 4 teams in one round against each other. Each team will play 3 matches in the group. All teams advance to the playoffs. In the quarter-finals, the first teams will always play against the fourth and the second teams against the third from the opposite groups, according to the final order after the end of the groups. The winners of the quarter-final matches advance to the semi-finals. The winners of the first two quarter-final matches will play together in the first semi-final match. The remaining two winning teams will play the second semi-final match together. The teams defeated in

the semi-final matches will play together in the bronze-medal game. The winners of the semi-finals advance to the final.

PROGRESS CRITERIA

A win in a basic group match means 3 points, a draw 1 point and a defeat 0 points. If two or more teams get the same number of points after the group matches, then about further progress, or order is decided by:

- 1. points from mutual matches
- 2. score difference from mutual matches
- 3. total score
- 4. draw

SHOOTOUT

In playoff matches, the match is played to a decision. If the score is tied at the end of the playing time, there is a five-minute overtime. In case of a draw, penalties follow.

A series of three penalty shootouts is played, followed by a so-called sudden death to decide. Players who have already started the first series of three penalties can start in the sudden death series.

AWARDS

The first team will win the trophy.

Players from 1st and 3rd teams will receive the medals.

Other players will receive commemorative medals.

Tournament MVP and the best goalkeeper will be awarded.

Every member of All stars team will get the small trophy.

REFEREE

All matches are officiated by referees with a Český florbal license.

GAME SCHEDULE

The organizer reserves the right to change the published schedule. In case of changes, all leaders of the cooperatives affected by the change will be informed. The obligations of the cooperatives are to monitor the info boards for possible changes, to which the organizer reserves the right. The boards are posted at the entrance to the hall, they are especially important during the final matches in groups, for smooth continuity and procedures for the playoffs (all information will also be found on the tournament website). In case of confusion, the team contacts the tournament management (+420 721 688 226) or the relevant manager of the arena.

ROSTER

The duties of each participating team include submitting a completed roster. The list is filled out and sent no later than April 20 2024. Any changes to the lists are presented during registration on the day of the start of the tournament. Only the players listed under their civil name on the roster enter the match. After the first match is played, the roster may be completed, but not by a player already listed on the roster of another participating team. This can always be done 60 minutes before the next match. During the tournament, players can only be registered in the tournament office.

PLAYER START

A player can start for only one team during the tournament. At the referee's request, the team must present identity cards or other documents that clearly identify the player and her age. The opponent

can also request a confrontation, however, no later than half-time of the disputed match and after paying the protest fee. Any unauthorized start of the player leads to a disqualification of the team from the match and to the exclusion of the player from the tournament.

TEAM STAFF

A member of the staff is a member of the team who will participate in the tournament as a coach, team leader, or another member of the team's staff. A member of the staff can enter areas that are only allowed for players. Each team must have AT LEAST one person over 18 years of age who will be the leader of the team. The leader of the team must be listed as a member of the staff on the team's list, during accreditation he must fill in his contact details for possible solutions to situations that concern the given team.

PROTESTS

The protest must be submitted in writing to the jury of the tournament or to the manager of the arena no later than 15 minutes after the end of the match. The fee for filing a protest is 500 CZK. If the protest is rejected, the fee is forfeited. Protests against referees' performance will not be accepted. The decision of the JURY of the tournament is final. The protest must contain:

- First and last name of the person submitting the protest
- Contact (mobile number)
- Team for which it is accredited in the tournament
- Written content of the protest.

RED CARDS

Technical penalty = sending off until the end of the given match

Penalty until the end of the match = automatic ban from the start in the following match.

WAITING PERIOD

At the tournament, it is not possible to use the waiting period due to time constraints. In case of non-appearance of the team, the match will be suspended to the disadvantage of the late team. In case of two suspensions as a result of late entry to the match, the given team will be excluded from the tournament and the results of its match will be annulled.

JERSEY COLOURS

In the case of identical colors of jerseys, the away team must change into a spare set of jerseys.

WARM UP

Warm-up before the match cannot take place on the field except for the bronze medal match and the final match.

TIME-OUT

Teams can use timeout during the whole tournament – 30 seconds per game.

MATCH LIST

The record from the match is automatically filled out in advance based on registration. Paper records are not used. We only use the result confirmation version, where after the match the team leader confirms the correctness of the result at the organizer's table with his signature. If the team manager does not make this confirmation within 5 minutes after the end of the match, it is considered automatically confirmed even without his signature. The tournament organizer is not responsible for any error in the result.

INSURANCE

Participants start at their own risk. The organizer is not responsible for any injury, illness or loss during the tournament.

DRESSING ROOM

Each team gets its own locker room for the entire match day. The team leader collects the key from her when she arrives at the hall in her name. The key is always handed over by the team leader when the team leaves the hall at its entrance.

ACCOMMODATION

To make sure you have as little work as possible in organising the tournament, we have arranged accommodation for you. We will accommodate the teams in one of two hotels.

Asport hotel - it is right in the area of the hall where the tournament will take place.

- single room 1200 CZK/person/night
- double room 850 CZK/person/night
- 3 room 734 CZK/person/night
- 4 room 650 CZK/person/night

Hotel Vista

- double room 850 CZK/person/night
- 3 room 750 CZK/person/night

For organizational reasons, the organizer decides in which hotel the team will be accommodated.

Accommodation is not included in the tournament price and must be paid to the tournament organizer no later than April 20, 2024.

FOOD

Breakfast is automatically provided for guests at the A-sport hotel. The tournament organizer will also provide lunches and dinners, which can be ordered by the tournament participants. Lunch and dinner will be provided for all at the A-sport hotel.

- Lunch (soup, main dish with meat at 150g, water with citrus fruits) 180 CZK
- Dinner (main meal with meat at 150g, wafer or fruit, water with citrus fruits) 180 CZK
